**ORDER DENYING PLAINTIFFS' MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION
OF THE ORDER GRANTING EXPEDITED MOTION OF DEFENDANT
JPMORGAN CHASE BANK, NATIONAL ASSOCIATION FOR ADDITIONAL
TIME TO RESPOND TO DEBTORS' SUMMARY JUDGMENT MOTION**

Upon the motion, dated May 25, 2009 (the "Motion") [Docket No. 25], of Washington Mutual, Inc. and WMI Investment Corp. (together, the "Debtors") for reconsideration of this Court's order granting the expedited motion of defendant, JPMorgan Chase Bank, National Association ("JPMorgan"), for additional time to respond to the Debtors' summary judgment motion, all as more fully set forth in the Motion; and the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors' having filed a joinder to the Motion on June 10, 2009 [Docket No. 34] (the

“Joinder”); and JPMorgan having filed an opposition to the Motion [Docket No. 37] (the “Opposition”); and the Court having jurisdiction to consider the Motion, the Joinder, the Opposition, and all related filings in connection therewith and the relief requested therein pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and 1334; and venue being proper before this Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409 to consider the Motion; and due and proper notice of the Motion, the Joinder, the Opposition, and all related filing having been provided, and it appearing that no other or further notice need be provided; and a hearing having been held before the Court with respect to the Motion, the Joinder, the Opposition, and related filings on June 24, 2009 (the “Hearing”); and upon the record of the Hearing and for the reasons set forth on the record of the Hearing, it is hereby

ORDERED that the Motion and the relief requested therein is denied.
